Implementation of Handicap Revision Policy

All Golfers are hereby informed that the **Handicap Revision Policy** will come into effect from **2nd March 2026**. The Policy has been framed in accordance with the **World Handicap System (WHS)** with the following objectives:

- To ensure fairness in competition
- To protect the integrity of Club tournaments
- To address abnormal scoring patterns
- To provide a structured and transparent mechanism for handicap revisions

Tournaments Subject to Handicap Revision

The following individual formats (including invitational tournaments) will be subject to Handicap Revision:

- Stroke Play
- Stableford
- Against Bogey

Formats Exempt from Handicap Revision

The following formats are not subject to this Policy:

- Match Play (Individual)
- Partnership formats (Better Ball, Aggregate Stableford, Partnership Matchplay)
- Scramble formats
- Alternate Shot formats
- Fun / social team events (unless declared otherwise)

Relationship with WHS Automatic Adjustments

Members are advised that WHS Rule 10.3 (Exceptional Score Reduction) will continue to apply automatically — a score differential 7.0 to 9.9 strokes below Handicap Index triggers an automatic -1 adjustment, and 10.0 or more below triggers an automatic -2 adjustment. The Club Handicap Revision under this Policy is applied in addition to any such WHS adjustment and is not a substitute for it.

Handicap Revision Structure

Where a player records a significantly under-handicap (net) performance in the above formats, a structured Handicap Index reduction will be applied as per the computation chart below. The Handicap Index reduction is applied on the Handicap Index calculated once every month.

Duration and Application of Revised Handicap

- The revised Handicap Index takes effect from the month following the tournament in which the performance was recorded.
- Subsequent abnormal performances during an active revision period may extend the duration of the revised Handicap Index.
- The revised Handicap Index overrides the WHS/GHIN calculated index for all Club events during the revision period.

Committee Authority

The Handicap Committee retains authority under WHS Rules 7.1 and 8.4 and may adjust any Handicap Index, alter the duration of revision, or apply adjustments outside the computation chart where the integrity of competition demands it. All decisions of the Handicap Committee shall be final and binding.
